May 25-29 - Senior Final Exams/Final Grades

June 6 - Commencement at Westover

In making a decision about the format for this year's commencement ceremony to honor the hard work of our Seniors, it was important that we not only observe TEA guidance and current health and safety guidelines, but also what is important to our learning community - families, connections, traditions, and more – and our past experiences.

HFA: Alameda School's 2020 Commencement Ceremony will be held in what TEA calls a "hybrid" format.
